



A Stewardship Moment

In today's second reading we hear Saint Paul urging members of the community at Thessalonica to direct their hearts to God's love through Christ. He wants them to be laser-focused on Christ, and nothing else. He desires that they be strengthened by the lord and shielded from what is not Christ-like.

Good stewards cultivate a "laser-sharp" focus on Christ; not on things that could give them a false or superficial images or ideals. Let's think about our own daily focus: Do we direct our hearts toward Christ or are there other "gods" that claim our attention? Our Career? Material possessions? Sexuality? Favorite sports team? Political Leanings? Does our daily life point to Christ so that those who are younger and less mature in their faith learn from our example?
