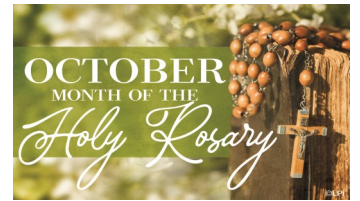
Protecting God's Children
