




### Sacrament of Baptism

- ⇒ Both parents must attend Baptismal preparation classes. Call the parish office to register 406-723-5407.
- ⇒ Must preregister, if no one preregisters then class will not take place.
- ⇒ Next Class: Monday, May 18th at 6:00 pm at the Neumann Center of Immaculate Conception

# **Sacrament of Holy Matrimony**

- ⇒ Arrangements must be made at the parish office at least six months in advance of the proposed wedding date in accordance with Canon Law.
- ⇒ Must attend marriage preparation classes which take place in the first quarter of every year. There are eight sessions that you are required to attend.
